Admissions Deadlines

Completed undergraduate applications must be submitted at least five (5) business days prior to the start of classes. Under certain circumstances, the University may institute an earlier priority admission deadline. Academic departments may also institute earlier admission deadlines to manage enrollment in their respective programs.

Most graduate applications have an earlier application deadline that is program-specific. These dates are listed on the Graduate Studies website.

International students have an earlier application deadline in accordance with the needs of obtaining a visa.

Withholding or providing incorrect information on your application is considered fraud and could impact your ability to attend the University.

Students who have not been in attendance for 720 days will have their admissions status ended and will need to reapply to the University. Details about how to reapply are on the University Admissions web site.
