POSITION: Mental Health Adjunct Clinical Instructor— Pre-Licensure Nursing Program

SALARY: \$1,819 per credit (clinicals are 2+ credits)

RESPONSIBILITIES: The responsibilities of an adjunct faculty for clinical instruction will be to supervise pre-licensure nursing student experiences in a mental health clinical setting. These positions require onboarding and submission of clinical documents required by clinical agencies and reviewing/evaluation of student's clinical work. Credit load and start date is variable depending on the clinical experience taught.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Active, unrestricted Registered Nurse licensure in the State of Minnesota.
- Master's degree preferred, will consider Baccalaureate degree
- A minimum of 3 years of clinical experience (5 years preferred if BS degree) as a Registered Nurse in mental health nursing.
- Demonstrated commitment to fostering a diverse working and learning environment.
